The course assumes the student is a complete beginner and we start with a Health and Safety briefing and an explanation of the tools and how to use them. All tools and materials will be provided. We will make a Simple garland using 3 rods. Then cut heavy duty withies for our base sticks.

Over the base sticks starting in the middle we will weave our weaving rods reducing their diameter as we work to both ends and shaping the platter as we go.
